A gifted instrumentalist, talented composer, and charismatic performer who, since the release of his first solo album in 1995, has created a series of recordings that have made him a virtual genre-of-one in the realm of contemporary jazz.

His most recent album, “To Love Again,” a collection of pop and jazz standards recorded with guest vocalists that include Paula Cole, Michael Buble, Jill Scott, Gladys Knight, and Steven Tyler from Aerosmith, debuted at #18 on the Billboard Top 200 chart. Its predecessor, “When I Fall In Love,” was #1 on the Traditional Jazz and the Top Jazz charts for an incredible 17 weeks. Botti and Sting's recording of “What Are You Doing For The Rest Of Your Life?” won the 2006 Grammy for Best Instrumental Arrangement Accompanying Vocalist(s).

Crossing the lines between contemporary jazz, traditional jazz and pop music, he has worked with a diverse array of artists in the studio and on stage, including Joni Mitchell, Natalie Merchant, and film composer John Barry. Botti's sold out appearance at the Count Basie Theatre last year spurred eager requests for his return.
